Dear Parent / Guardian

The Prime Minister, on Tuesday 23rd June, made announcements on easing restrictions on the population. Further guidance released confirmed:

Yesterday it was recommended that from 4th July 2020 people keep two metres away from others as a precaution or one metre when the risk can be mitigated by taking other precautions in the staying safe outside your home guidance. Over the coming weeks the Department for Education will publish further information and guidance to help schools prepare for a full return in September.

Primary schools should continue to operate in groups of no more than 15 and secondaries should not exceed 25% of year 10 and year 12 pupils in at any one time.

I have been delighted by how much our students have enjoyed returning to school over the past couple of weeks and whilst the 4th July is another step forward, we are still tied to the provision we are currently offering.

There are three big questions as a school we are awaiting further guidance on:

- The return of all students in September 2020 full time and the arrangements
- 2. How the exams will be conducted in Summer 2021
- 3. The National Tutoring Programme

As ever, as soon as further information is released, we will share our plans with you on how we will act upon them.

Social distancing post 4th July

The Government has announced changes to social distancing, to begin on 4th July. These changes will affect much of how we live our lives and how we can see the people we love.

Having reviewed our policies at school, we will continue to enforce 2m social distancing whilst on the school site and we encourage the students to do the same on their journeys to and from school.
