Re: Parking Complaints

During school drop-off and pick-up please be considerate of local residents.

Students who live locally should either walk or cycle to school. The cycle racks have been extended to increase bike storage.

If you must drive students, please drop them as far away from school as possible, to reduce congestion in neighbouring roads. Students should then walk the remainder of the journey into school.

When dropping off or collecting students;

- DO NOT park across driveways, dropped kerbs or on pavements
- DO NOT block roads
- DO NOT park on yellow lines, zig zags

This letter has been co-signed by the local Waverley Borough and Surrey County Councillors in response to increasing tension between parents and residents over parking in recent times.

Everyone understands the right of residents to live peacefully and the right of parents to get their children safely to school, however, if we are not able to self-police these problems the Councils may have to consider more formal action on what has become an increasing concern, which would be a shame.
