Coronavirius Closures 2020



Arrival

- On arrival all students should check in at Main Reception with the Duty member of the Senior Leadership Team.
- Once registered, they will direct you to the room where you can work from.
- Please ensure you wash your hands before arrival or at Main Reception

During the day

- In this room, you will be given a workstation or room to work in. You are to work at this station only (this will have been cleaned the previous day)
- You will work on the work set by your class teacher, through SharePoint and Office 365
- You can use the toilets by the Main Hall or another set identified to you
- Please do ask your teacher for help during the day, ensuring correct distance at all times
- For all movement around the school, remain at least 2 metres away from any individual
- For lunch, students will be taken outside but must remain at least 2 metres away from each other
- If you start to feel unwell, please let the teacher know

Social Distancing

- You must observe social distancing at all times
- You must stay at least 2 metres (6 feet) from any person
- Do not share resources or equipment throughout the day with anyone else

At the end of the day

- Please sign out and leave the school by the Main Entrance, remaining at least 2 metres from any person
- Your workspace will be cleaned, ready for the next day

Coronavirus Guidance

Handwashing and respiratory hygiene

There are general principles you can follow to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses, including:

Washing your hands more often - with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use a hand sanitiser when you get home or into work, when you blow your nose, sneeze or cough, eat or handle food

- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- Avoid close contact with people who have symptoms
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in a bin and wash your hands
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces in the home

Symptoms of a COVID-19 infection

The most common symptoms of COVID-19 are a new continuous cough and/or a fever/high temperature (37.8C or greater).

A new continuous cough is where you:

- have a new cough that's lasted for an hour
- have had 3 or more episodes of coughing in 24 hours
- are coughing more than usual

A high temperature is feeling hot to the touch on your chest or back (you don't need to measure your temperature). You may feel warm, cold or shivery.

Some people will have more serious symptoms, including pneumonia or difficulty breathing, which might require admission to hospital.
