As our teachers continue to provide excellent remote learning opportunities for students, we are excited to see all the students back in school, following a testing schedule that will commence on Monday 8 March. Our initial testing programme will run from Monday 8 March through to Wednesday 10 March, with face-to-face lessons resuming for all students on Thursday 11 March.

Support for families

I would like to share resources from the [Mental Health Foundation](#), which cover a range of strategies on returning to school, including practical advice for parents and caregivers relevant for when children and young people return to face-to-face learning.

Asymptomatic Testing of students

In line with Government guidance, we will conduct three tests on all students over two weeks. Rapid lateral flow testing is vitally important as it enables us to identify individuals with coronavirus (COVID-19) who do not have symptoms. Finding asymptomatic cases can help ensure the safety of our students and staff, and works to reduce transmission of the virus.

Testing on Monday 8 March to Wednesday 10 March:

- Students must arrive 10 minutes before their allocated test time wearing a face covering.
- We cannot accommodate siblings at the same time as each other due to our capacity for testing.
- We will not conduct tests on any student without the completed online consent.
- Once tested, students must return home. We will only notify you if the result is positive.
- Students accessing keyworker provision, will receive their test at the time specified below.
- Students do NOT need to wear their uniform to these appointments.

The second and third tests will be completed during lesson time from Thursday 11 March to Thursday 18 March. Subsequently students will be asked to complete twice weekly lateral flow tests at home. Further information regarding the home tests will be shared during the week beginning Monday 15 March.

Learning during testing period

- To avoid disruption to lessons on their testing day, students will be set Assignments through Teams.
- On days when students are not being tested, they will have Live Remote Lessons as usual.
- Keyworker provision will remain on offer for these three days.


At the end of next week I will outline the testing procedures to help students understand the process and the measures we have put in place for accurate and safe testing.

I strongly urge everyone to consent to testing to ensure the safety of the All Hallows Family is protected and to minimise disruption to future learning. This is a significant task and your support is greatly appreciated.
