### Year 12 Assessment Week


As another half term draws to a close, it has been lovely to see our Year 12 students working so hard in preparation for their upcoming assessments, and really utilising their free time in a productive manner. This week the Sixth Form Centre has been abuzz with hard work, and I am sure that the students will reap the rewards of their hard work in the coming weeks.

I am writing to inform you of the assessment process that will begin on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June and end on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> June. Students have been issued with their assessment timetable, which has been shared with you as well, via email. Please note that students with access arrangements have had these taken into consideration with our planning.

During the assessment week, some students will be granted Study Leave, based on their option choices, as not all subjects will be assessed at this time. The table below sets out the attendance requirement that we are expecting students to follow:

Student Option Choices	Study Leave?	Attendance requirement
Studying subjects which are all holding assessments	Study Leave	No need to attend College unless requiring help. No General RE Lessons.
Studying subjects with no assessment at this time*	No Study Leave	Students must attend College for all timetabled lessons, unless directed otherwise by their teacher. No General RE Lessons.
Studying a combination of assessed and non-assessed subjects*	Partial Study Leave	Students will need to attend their lessons as normal, using their free periods for study leave. However, if a student has an assessment in the afternoon, they may miss that morning's lessons. No General RE Lessons.

\*Non-assessed subjects: BTEC's, Art, Architecture, Photography, 3D Design, Graphic Design
