Parents Evening

Video Appointments between 4 – 7pm

We are very pleased to be able to maintain our parents evening schedule and ensure parents and students continue to receive feedback from teachers in relation to their progress. As you will be aware, the online site SchoolCloud is being used for these events enabling live video calls through pre-booked appointments.

The system restricts appointments to those teachers on your child's timetable and will limit the overall number of appointments that can be made, to a maximum of one per subject. Classes with more than one teacher will be invited to make an appointment with an assigned lead teacher. All appointments are programmed to last five minutes; whilst you may end the call early, please be aware that calls automatically cut off once the call time has expired.

Appointments will be made on a first-come-first-serve basis via the SchoolCloud system. The booking system will go live from **7pm on Friday 25th September**, when you will be able to log in and book appointments. The booking system will close on Wednesday 30th September, at 4pm.

To provide you with a detailed overview of your child's year ahead at All Hallows, a presentation will be released on the school website. This presentation enables you to gain valuable information in relation to the school itself, as well as specific details from their Head of Key Stage and Head of Year.
