### **Parking Complaints**

We are still receiving complaints from local residents about parking outside the school during drop off and collection times. Therefore, could I please ask that you be considerate of local residents.

Students who live locally should either walk or cycle to school. The cycle racks have been extended to increase bike storage.

If you must drive students to/from school, please drop them as far away from school as possible, to reduce congestion in neighbouring roads. Students should then walk the remainder of the journey into school.

When dropping off or collecting students, can I please remind you of the following;

- **DO NOT** park across driveways, dropped kerbs or on pavements;
- **DO NOT** block roads; and
- **DO NOT** park on yellow lines, zig zags.

Everyone understands the right of residents to live peacefully and the right of parents to get their children safely to school. However, if we are not able to self-police these problems, the Councils may have to consider more formal actions on what has become an increasing concern, which would be a shame.
